Norton show draws crowd to Gatlinburg

GATLINBURG — Holiday shoppers could buy everything from ladies' men's and children's apparel; jewelry; accessories; fragrances; toys; candles and gourmet food during last weekend's 24th annual Norton Show at the Gatlinburg Convention Center.

- Every inch of the building was packed with shoppers, eager to find the perfect gift.

The hallways and exhibit spaces were filled with vendors looking to make a hefty profit.

"This show has all the possibilities for shopping, from diamonds to sheets," said Debbie Winstead with German Roasted Nuts. "It's great for Christmas shopping."

Started by Tom and Linda Norton in 1987, the Norton Shows have turned into a full-blown shopping treasure trove. Four times a year

— March, June, September and November — over 450 exhibitors completely canvass the convention center. During the three-day show, over 20,000 people will filter through the building.

"You'll see customers come out with loads of merchandise," Tom Norton said. "Then they'll come back on Monday and buy more."

entire convention center, selling booth spaces to exhibitors from 26 different states. Norton estimates that 60 percent of their vendors are regulars.
